<b>Autumn Term 2 2024</b>			
<p>The intent for the <b>Autumn Term</b> Theme '<b>Cultural Celebrations</b>' is to support the pupils to gain the <u>Life-long Learning</u> knowledge and skills through <b>Science</b> materials, <b>Design Technology</b> materials and experience culture through <b>Music</b>. Through consistent routines and structures DT and PE sessions pupils will develop their <u>Independence skills</u> (EHCPs) and be provided with knowledge and skills of the wider world through <u>Imaginative &amp; Meaningful Experiences</u> and develop the ability to collaborate with peers through <u>Togetherness &amp; Inclusivity</u>. Theme sessions will have a specific focus linked to Science materials, Design Technology materials or Music with clear learning intentions where the accumulative knowledge through the term and beyond will work towards the pathway end points. Festivals and other cultural celebrations should be used to carry the theme to ensure lessons are <u>Interesting</u> &amp; provide real-life <u>Opportunities</u> for cross curricular links. Through their understanding of sports &amp; healthy lifestyles pupils will develop strategies to support better <u>Mental Health &amp; Wellbeing</u>.</p>			
<b>Class Focus</b>	<i>This half term we will be working on children tolerating others playing alongside and taking turns. We will be encouraging children to participate in non-preferred activities and getting used to our daily routine.</i>
